





10 THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

- REMOVAL OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER
 Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS)
 is replacing your current Medicare Card with a
 NEW CARD.
- NEW BENEFICIARY NUMBER ASSIGNED
 Your SSN will be replaced with a Medicare
 Beneficiary Identifier (MBI) of 11 letters & numbers
 to help protect your identity.
- YOUR NEW CARD WILL BE MAILED TO YOU Medicare will MAIL new cards to beneficiaries between April 2018 and April 2019.
- **UPDATE YOUR MAILING ADDRESS**To confirm that your mailing address is up-to-date, go to www.ssa.gov/myaccounts, call 1-800-772-1213, or go to your local Social Security office.
- NO IMPACT ON YOUR BENEFITS
 The new card doesn't change your benefits or coverage.



- DESTROY YOUR OLD CARD!

 As soon as the new card is received, SHRED THE OLD CARD and start using the new one.
- MEDICARE WILL NOT CALL YOU

 If someone calls you regarding your Medicare card,
 HANG UP. It is a SCAM!
- NEW CARDS = NEW SCAMS

 Beware! Scammers will pose as Medicare reps to take advantage of beneficiaries during the transition.
- THERE IS NO CHARGE FOR NEW CARD
 If someone says you need to pay for your new card, that is a SCAM!
- PROTECT YOURSELF!
 To deter Medical Identity Theft, keep your Medicare Card/MBI in a secure place and share it only with those you know/trust.
