What Can You Do to Prevent Healthcare Fraud?

Learn how to protect you or your loved one from healthcare fraud by understanding the Medicare Summary Notices (MSNs) or Explanation of Benefits (EOBs) you receive.

- Presentation length: 30-60 minutes
- In-depth review of Medicare Summary Notice (MSN) forms
- Review of tools to help you reconcile charges for healthcare services and supplies
- How to appeal Medicare decisions
- Common issues in healthcare billing
- Medicare and consumer fraud prevention tips

Cooking for One: Fraud Free Recipes
