The SMP (Senior Medicare Patrol) recruits and teaches senior volunteers and professionals such as doctors, nurses, accountants, law enforcement personnel, teachers and others to help Medicare and Medicaid beneficiaries become better health care consumers. Volunteers work in their communities, AAAs and senior centers to help identify deceptive health care practices such as double-billing, overcharging, or providing unnecessary and inappropriate services.

The Indiana SMP Program and its volunteers provide educational materials and information to the public about potential scams and how to protect oneself. Volunteers provide training to consumers and organizations regarding Medicare and Medicaid fraud detection and prevention through presentations, participation in health fairs, senior expos, and by distribution of materials.
